We enforce Leave No Trace principles for all our cycling activities.

Trail Cycling:

Leave No Trace

- Small groups
- Pack in/pack out
- Don't make new trails
- Respect nature
- Respect the trails

Stay on the trails

- Don't cut corners or create new trails
- Avoid short cuts
- You are more likely to damage your bike off the trail – sticks and bush can damage derailleurs etc

Obey track closures

- Land managers will close trails for safety and environmental reasons
- Respect the work done by the trail builders

Keep your bike clean

- Avoid spreading weeds and soils borne plant disease
- Your bike lasts longer (less waste)

Off Road/Mountain Biking

No Skids – Ride don't slide

- Skids damage the trail surface and accelerates erosion.
- Avoid clay based trails in wet weather

Stay on the trails

- Don't cut corners or create b-lines.
- Can cause erosion or environmental damage
- Walk an obstacle if you can't ride it
- Avoid short cuts
- You are more likely to damage your bike off the trail – sticks and bush can damage derailleurs etc

Obey track closures

- Land managers will close trails for safety and environmental reasons
- Respect the work done by the trail builders
